### **Embassy of the Maldives Marks 60th Independence Day**



25 July 2025, Washington, D.C.; The Embassy of the Republic of Maldives joined Maldivians around the world in celebrating the 60th anniversary of the country's independence.

On behalf of the Government and people of the Maldives, the Embassy conveyed heartfelt Independence Day greetings and reaffirmed its commitment to advancing the country's diplomatic engagement and shared values of peace, sustainability, and cooperation.

During their meeting, they welcomed the growing engagement between the Maldives and the United States and discussed ways to continue strengthening bilateral cooperation.

15 July 2025, Washington, D.C.; Ambassador Abdul Ghafoor Mohamed attended a ceremony hosted by H.E. Sedat Önal, Ambassador of the Republic of Türkiye to the United States, to commemorate Türkiye's Democracy and National Unity Day. The event, held at the Turkish Embassy, brought together members of the diplomatic community to reflect on the importance of democratic values and national solidarity.

The Republic of Maldives and the Republic of Türkiye established diplomatic relations in 1979.
