Among the graduates was Colonel Ahmed Thohir of the Maldives National Defence Force, who completed a Master of Arts in Strategic Security Studies.

Colonel Thohir was honored with the Outstanding International Fellow Award, a Distinction, and the Ambassador's Award in recognition of his exceptional academic performance and leadership.
